## CPSC Vintage Riders

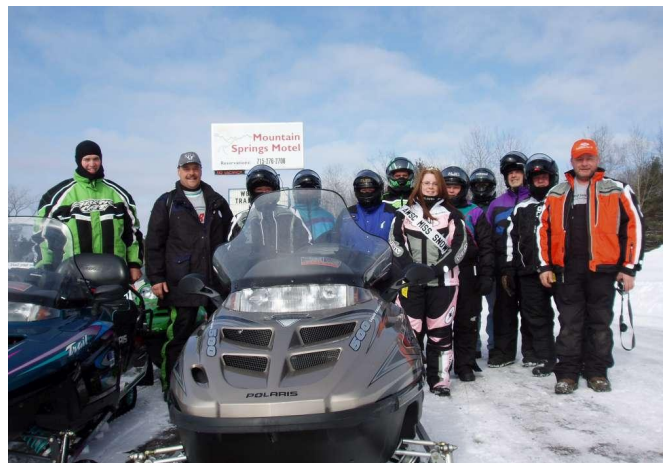
Our Club now has a Vintage Sled Group

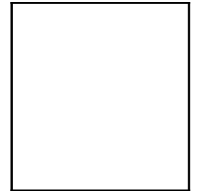
## R4RD Benefit Ride
