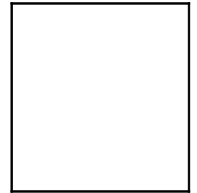
The CPSC scholarship program will be 100% funded by a new raffle- the 500 ticket CPSC Penny Raffle. Only 500 tickets, numbered 1-500 will be sold. Tickets will be randomly drawn when purchased, and the price for each ticket will be based on the number of the ticket- the ticket number is the price you pay. Ticket #1 will cost the buyer one cent. Ticket #150 will cost the buyer \$1.50, and so on. The most expensive ticket will be #500, which will cost \$5.00.



Prizes for the first round will include this outdoor fireplace, a Garmin 1390T GPS unit, and a \$50 Wendt's Lakeside Inn gift certificate. Tickets will go on sale Saturday, September 25 at the Vintage Show and Swap Meet (also at all future meetings), and will be available until all 500 are sold.
