Change in Insurance Policy Announced

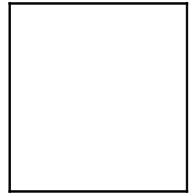
The AWSC office has announced that the Accidental Death and Dismemberment insurance benefit through American Income Life has been increased from \$2000 to \$2500 for all current AWSC primary members and his or her spouse. This benefit increase includes all children under the age of 19 who are now covered under the family membership. This benefit is for accidents of all kinds- not just snowmobile related.
