

CPSC Trail Brushing Paperwork Instructions

There are two forms to be filled in when you go out brushing trails:

The Work Day Sign-in Sheet-

Must be in original handwriting of each person who is helping and it must be legible. Any signatures that appear to be written by the same person will be voided by the DNR and will not count.

Use one work day sign-in sheet per day. Do not put multiple days on one sheet. Record the date on each sheet. Please leave the hours and location blank on this sheet.

This sheet must be neat and clean and please record only the information above- nothing more and nothing less.

The Equipment Log-

This log does not go to the DNR. It is a worksheet for us to figure out where you were and what equipment was used. Please record how many trucks, chain saws, pole saws, ATV's, snowmobiles, tractors, and trailers, etc. that you used that day. It is on this sheet that you log in the time of day you were out and for how long. You can scratch and scribble and make notes on this sheet.

Please make arrangements to have these forms dropped off at the shop or with Deb Uhlenbrauck. Questions regarding these forms should be directed to Deb.
